

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection ("DEEP") submits this letter in reference to Petition No. 1339. DEEP is unable to meet the February 12, 2018 deadline provided by the Council in its Connecticut State Agencies Comment Memo of January 16, 2018 and requests that the Council grant an extension of 30 days to ensure our staff can adequately compile information on the environmental and natural resource impacts of the proposal.

DEEP's review of Petition No. 1339 involves the review of Wallingford Renewable Energy LLC proposal by multiple disciplines and programs within the department, both in preparation for our comments to the Council and to ensure that subsequent permit submittals and reviews for the project are handled in the most efficient and consistent manner.
