Good morning, Attorney Hoffman.

With reference to Petition 1339, could you please clarify the following two items:

1. On page 1, second paragraph of the March 9, 2018 DEEP comment letter, the heading reads, "New England Clean Energy Multi-State Project Solicitation," and the paragraph states that "WRE submitted this project into the New England Clean Energy Request for Proposals (RFP), a three state solicitation by DEEP, in conjunction with Massachusetts and Rhode Island." This three state RFP solicited proposals for projects with a generating capacity of more than 20 megawatts. However, according to the text of the petition and the DEEP webpage, the project was selected in the "Small Scale Energy RFP," which RFP solicited projects with a generating capacity between 2 and 20 megawatts. 2. On page 6, fifth paragraph of the March 9, 2018 DEEP comment letter, DEEP refers to construction occurring on the MIRA property on March 3, 2018. Specifically, DEEP states, "Unlike the description in the Petition (Page E-14) and in the response to Council interrogatory #34, the fencing extended flush to the ground rather than providing for a 6" gap for turtle and other small animal passage." Did Wallingford Renewable Energy construct a fence on the MIRA property? If so, when? Is Wallingford Renewable Energy currently engaged in any construction activities on the MIRA property related to fence installation?

Please provide clarification on these items when you have a chance. We would appreciate it.
