

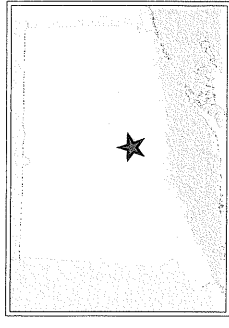

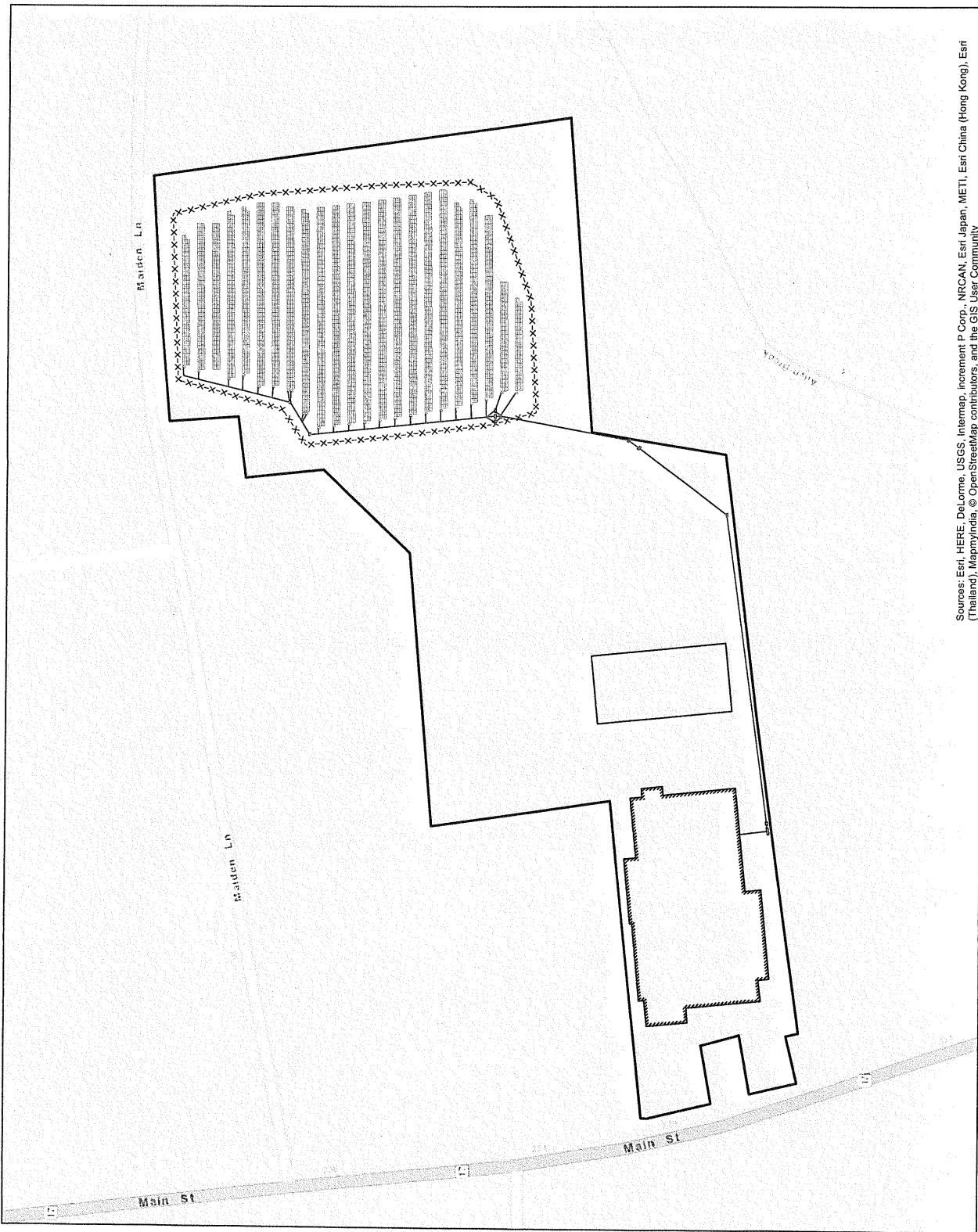
**Site Plan**
