RE: **PETITION NO. 1346** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the replacement and relocation of an existing telecommunications facility and an existing relay and control enclosure located at Manchester Substation, 250 Olcott Street, Manchester, Connecticut, and related substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence of July 16, 2019 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on July 20, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision of July 20, 2018, your request to perform work until 2:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 17, 2019 through Saturday, July 20, 2019 is hereby approved. The extended hours are necessary to accept delivery of ten sections of the new control enclosure (which will enter CT with only one section per truck per hour with a State Police escort). Offloading of the sections will only occur until 10:00 p.m. on each of the delivery days from July 16, 2019 through July 19, 2019. After 10:00 p.m., the sections will remain on the trucks for offloading the next day.

Due to the change in the delivery schedule, installation of the control enclosure sections on site will also require extended hours on Sunday, July 21, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Such additional hours are also hereby approved. Construction equipment will include, but not be limited to, light stands, a crane and hand tools.

This approval applies only to the request for extended work hours in your email of July 16, 2019. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

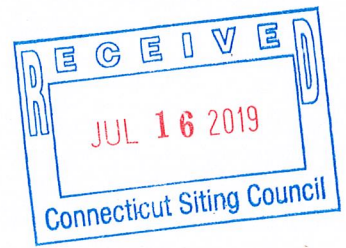

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Subsequent to requesting and receiving approval for the extended hours from 7PM through 10PM, for this evening through Friday, July 19, 2019, Eversource was notified that the CT State Police will only allow the transport of the control enclosure sections on CT roads after 6PM. In addition, each truck carrying one control enclosure section each and being escorted by the CT State Police, has to travel on a staggered schedule with only one truck entering CT per hour. Due to these restrictions, transport of the 10 sections of the control enclosure with each section on a separate truck is planned to occur over four evenings starting today, July 16, 2019 through Friday, July 29, 2019. Considering travel times from the CT border in Danbury to the substation in Manchester, Eversource is requesting additional extended hours until 2AM on Wednesday, July 17, 2019, Thursday, July 18, 2019, Friday, July 19, 2019 and Saturday, July 20, 2019. Offloading of the sections will only occur until 10PM on each of the delivery days of today, July 16, 2019 through Friday, July 19, 2019; after 10PM the sections will remain on the trucks for offloading the next day.

Due to this change in the delivery schedule, installation of the control enclosure sections on site will also require additional extended hours on Sunday, July 21, 2019 from 7AM to 7PM.

Equipment required for both the offloading and the installation of the control enclosure sections are light stands, a crane and hand tools.

All the necessary Town of Manchester permits for the transport of these control house enclosure sections over Town roads have been obtained and we will notify the Town of Manchester of these additional extended work hours prior to this evening's requested extended hours.
