The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence of November 21, 2019 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on July 20, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision of July 20, 2018, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the following Sundays: November 24, 2019, December 8, 2019 and December 15, 2019 is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are required to recover lost time due to delays within the schedule resulting from an incorrect bill of materials and the associated design changes to the relay and control panels to ensure work can be completed within the scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for Sunday work hours in your email of November 21, 2019. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.
