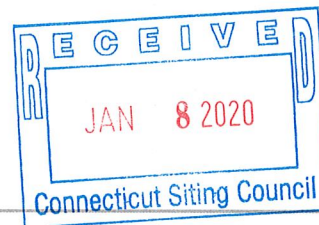

Eversource seeks Council staff approval for extended work hours for the above referenced project on this Sunday, January 12, 2020 from 7AM to 7PM. The project work schedule this week during the current outage included major equipment cutovers which are dependent on switching and require clearance approvals before execution. However, the required clearance was delayed one and half days. This delay necessitates working this Sunday to keep to the work schedule planned during the current available outage from January 6 through January 17.
