RE: PETITION NO. 1351 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Wallingford to Branford Upgrade Project consisting of the replacement of approximately 10 miles of its existing No. 1655 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line structures within existing Eversource electric transmission line right of way between the existing East Wallingford Junction located at Traditions Golf Course in Wallingford and the existing Branford Substation located at 272 East Main Street in Branford, Connecticut, traversing Wallingford, North Haven, East Haven, North Branford and Branford, and related electric transmission line structure improvements.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence dated May 31, 2019 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on December 7, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision of December 7, 2018, your request to perform work from 8 AM to 6 PM on the following Sundays - June 2, June 9, June 16, and June 23 - is hereby approved. The additional work hours are necessary to complete drilling, concrete work and the installation of transmission structures #4761 and #4764 in North Branford, and #4781 in Branford during scheduled outages.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours, dated May 31, 2019. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.


