PETITION NO. 1352 – Nutmeg Solar, LLC, petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 19.6-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility on approximately 162 acres comprised of 9 separate parcels located generally south of Bailey Road and east of Route 191 (Broad Brook Road), and associated electrical interconnection to Eversource Energy's Scitico

Substation at 20 Bailey Road in Enfield, Connecticut.

The current deadline for a final decision on the above-mentioned petition for a declaratory ruling is April 17, 2019.

Due to the cancellation of the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) Energy/Telecommunications meeting on April 11, 2019, the Council needs additional time to render a final decision.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176(i), "If an agency does not issue a final decision within one hundred and eighty days after the filing of a petition therefor, or within such longer period as may be agreed by the parties, the agency shall be deemed to have decided not to issue such ruling." (Emphasis added).

The Council hereby requests the parties and intervenors to this proceeding to respond in writing on or before April 3, 2019 as to whether there is agreement to grant the Council an extension of time to May 1, 2019 to render a final decision on this petition.
