The evidentiary record is developed by the Council; the petitioner, parties and intervenors in the proceeding; and members of the public who speak at the public hearing, if one is held, or submit written statements to the Council.

All documents filed to date are available at the Council's office or on our website under pending matters. This petition will be placed on a future Council meeting agenda for discussion and decision.

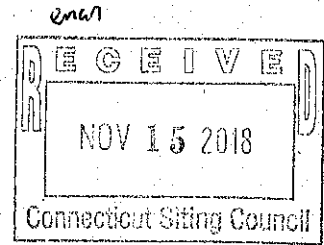

MOTION OF THE TOWN OF ENFIELD FOR PARTY STATUS
AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Enfield (Enfield/the Town) hereby moves the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") to designate Enfield as a party in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 4-176 and 16-50k and the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies § 16-50j-40. In support of this motion Enfield states the following:

1. The Council established this proceeding to consider the application of Nutmeg Solar, LLC's Petition for a Declaratory Ruling for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 19.6 megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric

generating facility located on approximately 162 acres comprised of 9 separate parcels located generally south of Bailey Road and east of Route 191 (Broad Brook Road), and associated electrical interconnection to Eversource Energy's Scitico Substation at 20 Bailey Road in Enfield, Connecticut.



2. Enfield seeks to participate on behalf of the interests of its 44,000 residents. Enfield's residents shall be specifically affected by the Council's decision and its participation in this proceeding is necessary to represent the interests of those residents.

Enfield proposes to participate in this proceeding relative to the issues associated with the Petition, including but not limited to participation in any hearings held by the Council, cross examination of witnesses, submission of pre-filed testimony or other written exceptions and participation in oral argument, if any.
4. As the legal rights, duties and privileges of the residents of Enfield are directly affected by this proceeding, Enfield respectfully requests that the Council grant Enfield party status.
5. Further, based on the foregoing Enfield also respectfully requests a Public Hearing in this matter.
