

Dear Chairman Stein, Vice Chairman Murphy, Executive Director Bachman, and Distinguished Members of the Connecticut Siting Council,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments regarding Petition No. 1352.

While we were pleased to see that the Federal Aviation Administration has been consulted on this project with respect to facility height, due to the proposed development's proximity to nearby airports, the CAA respectfully requests a copy of any glare studies that have been developed to understand the impacts that this could have on air traffic in the area. As I have noted to the council in the past, glare from photovoltaic facilities can sometimes impact pilots in the vicinity of those facilities, and a glare study would provide important information to understand the full impacts that this project could have on aviation in the state.
