- 1. Can T-Mobile remain on the existing flagpole facility at 1245 Dixwell Avenue in Hamden until the proposed, permanent 130-foot tower at 445 Putnam Avenue in Hamden is approved?
- 2. Is the temporary tower being designed to support other carriers besides T-Mobile?
- 3. The equipment compound associated with the temporary tower is shown on Site Plan C-1.1 as 35' x 90'. The Visual Assessment (Petition Attachment 4) describes the tower enclosure as 26' x 26' feet. Please clarify.
- 4. Describe the ballast foundation and associated framing in more detail.
- 5. Estimate when the proposed temporary facility would be installed and how long it would remain operational?
