

I write on behalf of CP Middletown Solar I, LLC and CP Middletown Solar II, LLC, wholly owned subsidiaries of Citrine Power, LLC (collectively "Citrine"). Citrine intends to file with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") a petition for declaratory ruling ("Petition") that a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is not required.

The Petition addresses the construction, operation and maintenance of a 1.0 megawatt ("MW") alternating current ("AC") and a 0.986 MW AC ground mounted solar photovoltaic electric generating facility, both of which would be located off of Meriden Road (Route 66) in Middlefield and Middletown, Connecticut ("Project"). The Project would be situated on a portion of several parcels of land, with the Project area totaling approximately 8.7 acres. The Project would include the installation of photovoltaic modules, inverters and transformers, electrical lines and a perimeter fence and slight improvements to an existing access road.


