MOTION OF NUTMEG SOLAR, LLC FOR PARTY STATUS

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes ("Conn. Gen. Stat.") §§ 4-176, 4-177a and 16-50k, and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies § 16-50j-14, Nutmeg Solar, LLC ("Nutmeg Solar") hereby moves the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") for designation as a party in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of its petition, Nutmeg Solar states as follows:

- 1. Nutmeg Solar is an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC ("NEER"), which in turn is an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy, Inc. ("NextEra"), headquartered at 700 Universe Boulevard, Juno Beach, Florida 33408.
- 2. This proceeding relates to Petition 1352, in which the Council issued a declaratory ruling to Nutmeg Solar approving the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 19.6-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility (the "Nutmeg Solar Project") on approximately 162 acres, comprised of 9 separate parcels, located generally south of Bailey Road and east of Route 191 (Broad

Brook Road), and associated electrical interconnection to The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy's ("Eversource's") Scitico Substation ("Scitico") at 20 Bailey Road in Enfield, Connecticut.

3. Eversource has filed Petition 1376 (the "Petition") with the Council seeking a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50g *et seq.* for the modifications to Scitico, the existing 1976 transmission line that terminates at Scitico, and for installation of a 330-foot new 115-kV underground transmission line on Eversource and private property in Enfield (the "Project"). The purpose of the Project is to provide an electrical interconnection between Scitico and the Nutmeg Solar Project's Collector Substation. The privately-held property is subject to a purchase option held by Nutmeg Solar. The Nutmeg Solar Project cannot operate without Council review and approval of the Project facilities. Accordingly, Nutmeg Solar has substantial rights, duties and privileges at issue in this proceeding that will be specifically affected by the Council's decision in this proceeding pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 4-177a.

- 4. Nutmeg Solar proposes to participate in this proceeding, including but not limited to participation in discovery, participation in any hearings held by the Council, cross-examination of any witnesses, and submission of briefs. The participation of Nutmeg Solar will not impair the orderly conduct of this proceeding, and will enhance the Council's consideration of the issues raised in the Petition.
