1. Map sheet 8 of the petition illustrates Structure 5952 is adjacent to vernal pool 3. Is it possible to eliminate structure 5952 and shift structure 5953 west to compensate for a practical span length to structure 5951 or in the alternative shift structure 5952 and work pad further east away from the vernal pool?
2. On map sheet 1 of the petition, would structures 5904 and 5905 be accessed from the existing driveway at lot LLN 3014 on Stepstone Hill Road? Explain.
3. Would Eversource require any other permits or approvals (e.g., USACOE) for temporary and permanent wetland impacts? Explain.
