RE: **PETITION NO. 1058** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company Declaratory Ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed 1990 line structure replacement project consisting of modifications of two sections of an existing 115-kV transmission line from Stevenson Substation to Frost Bridge Substation and from Baldwin Junction to Baldwin Substation traversing the municipalities of Monroe, Oxford, Middlebury, Waterbury and Watertown, Connecticut. **D&M Plan Revision.**

Dear Ms. Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated July 7, 2017 regarding the revision to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced site that was approved by the Council on July 25, 2013.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), your request for the installation of lighting on Structures No. 11167, 11168 and 11169 of the 1990 Line within the Eversource transmission line right-of-way in Oxford and Middlebury as required by the Federal Aviation Administration determination is hereby approved. The required lighting will be steady-state red obstruction lighting installed on top of the three transmission line structures.

This approval applies only to the D&M Plan revision dated July 7, 2017. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.
