The United Illuminating Company (“UI”) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on May 19, 2014 that UI proposed modification of the Sackett Substation would comply with the petition criteria in Section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. The Council included conditions regarding the work undertaken pursuant to modification.
