

Dear Attorney Kipnis:

At a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on July 11, 2013, the Council acknowledged the Request to Withdraw without prejudice by CMEEC regarding the above-referenced petition of the installation of 5.0 megawatt generator facilities at the 57 Salem Turnpike, Norwich and 145 Old Salem Road, Norwich locations, as stated in your letter dated June 24, 2013. The Council understands the 10 Wisconsin Avenue, Norwich location was constructed and is in operation.

The Council declares this matter to no longer be pending before this agency. Please note that if you decide to present an amended request to the Council in the future for the 57 Salem Turnpike and 145 Old Salem Road locations that such a request will need to be submitted as a new filing that must follow the applicable statutory and regulatory requirements for a new petition for a declaratory ruling.
