

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Dear Attorney Bachman:

As you know, I represent the Town of South Windsor, Connecticut, Mestek, Inc. and MacKeeber Associates, LLC, an affiliate of Mestek, Inc. (jointly referred to as the "Parties"). The Parties, today, filed a Request for Modification of the above referenced Petition.

The Connecticut Siting Council had previously extended the date by which the fuel cell must be operational to December 31, 2017. As the Parties are seeking a Modification of the location of the fuel cell, and has received approval of the Public Utility Regulatory Authority for the assignment of Power Purchase Agreement, which includes revised milestones, including a revised date by which the fuel cell must be operational, the Parties would respectfully request that the Connecticut Siting Council, as part of its consideration of the Request for Modification approval an extension of the operational date of the fuel cell from December 31, 2017 to June 30, 2019. This will ensure sufficient time to meet the requirements of the Power Purchase Agreement.
