

Dear Executive Director Bachman:

This letter is respectfully submitted on behalf of American Tower Corporation ("ATC") and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T"). Our records reflect that the approval for Petition 1108 is due to expire on August 22nd of this year if construction of the approved facility modifications is not complete. The Petitioners hereby respectfully request a one-year extension of the Petition approval.

It is important to note that AT&T and ATC are currently finalizing plans for minor modifications of the design approved in Petition 1108. These changes include: 1) a reduced number of proposed antennas and equipment to be installed by AT&T 2) elimination of AT&T's generator and 3) installation of a shared generator by ATC within the existing compound. Once the plans for these minor modifications are complete they will be submitted to the Siting Council for review and approval. In order to assure sufficient time for completion of the final design details, submission to and review by the Siting Council and final construction we respectfully request an extension of the Petition to August 22, 2018.
