Dear Attorney Morrissey:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated October 23, 2015 regarding the revision to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced site that was approved by the Council on September 3, 2015.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), your request for the repositioning of the inner row of silt fencing to accommodate construction, and to temporarily create truck access through silt fencing to deliver landscape material to adjacent properties is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the D&M Plan revision detailed in your letter dated October 23, 2015. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the project developer or Petitioner is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.
