RE: **PETTITION NO. 1140** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed reconductoring of a portion of an existing 115-kV transmission line extending from Barbour Hill Substation in South Windsor to Manchester Substation in Manchester, Connecticut and modifications to Barbour Hill Substation and Manchester Substation.

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated December 14, 2017 regarding Sunday work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was approved by the Council on April 20, 2015.

Pursuant to the Council's April 20, 2015 Decision on this petition and Condition No. 1 of the Council's July 21, 2017 Decision on the amendment to this petition, your request for construction hours at Barbour Hill Substation in South Windsor on Sunday, December 17, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to support the installation of the north sound wall for the transformer on the west side of Barbour Hill Substation is hereby approved. The Sunday hours were requested to allow the sound wall installation to be completed during a scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the Sunday construction hours requested in your December 17, 2017 correspondence. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

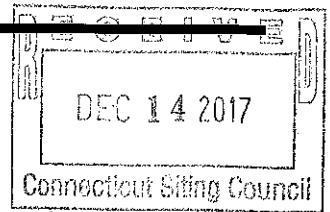

Eversource Energy is requesting approval of work hours from Connecticut Siting Council staff for Sunday (December 17) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. to support the erection of the north sound wall for the transformer on the west side of the Barbour Hill Substation during a scheduled outage. Due to a delay in delivery materials and the unforeseen need to make several field modifications due to fabrication errors, the wall erection on Sunday is required to place the transformer in service by the end of this month.
