RE: **PETITION NO. 1140** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed reconductoring of a portion of an existing 115-kV transmission line extending from Barbour Hill Substation in South Windsor to Manchester Substation in Manchester, Connecticut and modifications to Barbour Hill Substation and Manchester Substation.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your e-mail correspondence dated September 12, 2018 regarding Sunday work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on April 20, 2015.

Pursuant to the Council's April 20, 2015 Decision on this petition and Condition No. 1 of the Council's July 21, 2017 Decision on the amendment to this petition, your request for Sunday construction hours from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at Barbour Hill Substation in South Windsor on September 16 and September 23, 2018 to complete the sound wall for the transformer on the east side of the substation is hereby approved. The request is due to a delay in the delivery of the sound panel and to complete work within the scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the Sunday construction hours requested in your September 12, 2018 correspondence. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Thank you for your attention and cooperation.

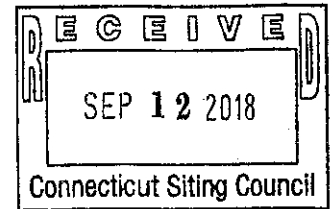
