RE: PETITION NO. 622A – T-Mobile Northeast LLC (T-Mobile) request to amend its declaratory ruling pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k for the proposed relocation of an existing T-Mobile facility attached to an Eversource electric transmission line structure (#826) onto an approved replacement electric transmission line structure (#826) within the existing Eversource right-of-way located at 1975 Huntington Road, Stratford, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Sabo:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received the petition for the above-referenced facility on January 16, 2018.

According to Section 16-50j-39a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, “no declaratory ruling shall be issued to any person until a complete petition containing all information deemed relevant by the Council has been filed.”

Staff has reviewed this petition for completeness and has identified a deficiency in notice to the underlying property owner. The underlying property owner is listed in the petition map C-1 as the owner of parcel “A”; however, that property owner was not provided notice of the petition as stated in Attachment J of the petition. Pursuant to Section 16-50j-40 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, “Prior to submitting a petition for a declaratory ruling to the Council, the petitioner shall, where applicable, provide notice to each person other than the petitioner appearing as record as an owner of property which abuts the proposed primary or alternative sites of the proposed facility, each person appearing of record as an owner of the property or properties on which the primary or alternative proposed facility is to be located, and the appropriate municipal officials and government agencies. Proof of such notice shall be submitted with the petition for declaratory ruling.”

Therefore, the petition is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that the petitioner provide proof of service of notice of the petition for a declaratory ruling to the underlying property owner on or before February 2, 2018. If additional time is needed to provide notice to the underlying property owner, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to February 2, 2018.
