Dear Mr. Morissette:

The Council is in receipt of your correspondence dated January 8, 2010, requesting an amendment to the above referenced petition, approved by the Council on July 16, 2009. The amendment includes the replacement of 350 feet of conductors on the 3533 line from the Scovill Rock Substation to the first structure outside of the substation (structure #12069). As shown on the diagram submitted, only new conductors would be installed. No new transmission structures are proposed.

Although the work is approximately 2.6 miles from the section of line that was the subject of Petition 906, the Council understands the work is a necessary component of overall the project and thus grants administrative approval of the amendment.
