Development and Management Plan Change – North Bloomfield Substation to
Connecticut / Massachusetts State Border 345-kV Overhead Transmission Line

Dear Mr. Stein:

The Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") approved The Connecticut Light and Power Company's ("CL&P") Development and Management ("D&M") Plan for the North Bloomfield Substation to Connecticut / Massachusetts State Border 345-kV Overhead Transmission Line via a letter sent to me on October 27, 2010. Included in Appendix F of that plan was a "Project Change Approval Process" and, in accordance with that process, CL&P is enclosing 16 copies of a sketch map of a proposed footpath and seeking the Council's approval of the following D&M Plan change:

1. Construct a short footpath within the CL&P right-of-way over the property of Mr. Edward Pelletier, 196 Newgate Road, East Granby, CT. See the enclosed sketch map for proposed footpath details. The footpath, approximately 4 feet in width, will restore a less-steep pedestrian access over a berm adjacent to the right-of-way access road, which functions as part of the drainage plan (see Appendix E of the D&M Plan, LL#1083). The Pelletier family uses this access over their rear yard to cross the CL&P right-of-way to reach the Metacomet Trail.

This is a "minor" and "not urgent" change, as defined in the Appendix F process.
