CL&P'S RESPONSE TO THE CONNECTICUT ENERGY ADVISORY BOARDS PETITION TO BECOME AN INTERVENOR

Statement of Position

The Connecticut Light and Power Company ("CL&P") does not object to the request of the Connecticut Energy Advisory Board ("CEAB") to intervene before the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") in this docket, provided that its participation in the Docket is limited to that it requests.

Discussion

The CEAB seeks permission to intervene for the limited purpose of explaining its Evaluation Report and "answer[ing] questions pertaining to its Report..." (Petition, ¶¶ 5, 7) The CEAB has not sought permission to take discovery from other parties and intervenors.

As the Council's regulation Sec. 16-50j-15b states, an "intervenor's participation shall be limited to those particular issues, that state of the proceeding, and that degree of involvement ... that the Council shall permit such intervention is allowed."

The CEAB's enabling legislation does not explicitly authorize it to intervene in Council proceedings, and appears to contemplate that the CEAB's participation will be limited to issuing a report evaluating the RFP responses it receives, as well as the application that triggered an RFP, and providing that report to the Council. Conn. Gen. Stats. 16a-7c(f). However, providing an explanation of such a report appears to be a reasonable adjunct power to the power to prepare the report which may therefore be implied. Such an explanation may be provided, in particular, in response to Interrogatories and Data Requests directed to the CEAB by the Council and other participants in the Docket.

However, that is not to say that the CEAB should be allowed to impose additional burdens on CL&P. CL&P and its consultants have heretofore devoted extensive time and resources to provide and develop voluminous data at the request of the CEAB, in order to enable the CEAB to prepare its Evaluation

Report. *See*, the Inventory of information provided in response to data Request OCC-01-Q-OCC-13 (copy attached). Further such requests at this stage of the proceeding could impair the orderly conduct of the proceeding. (see Conn. Gen. Stat. §4-177a(b)(2).

Conclusion

CL&P requests that if the Council grants the CEAB's petition to intervene that it do so only with the limitation that the CEAB has requested, that is, that the CEAB's participation be limited to explaining its report filed in this docket, including in response to Data Requests directed to it by other participants in the Docket.
