On behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") and enclosed for filing in the above referenced matter please find:


1. Pre-filed direct testimony of Mr. Dey, Mr. Libertine and Mr. Shamas

By way of this letter, we also wish to address one procedural matter at this point in time. In discussions at the pre-hearing conference, the Town expressed an interest in having the form of the tower changed from that as approved by the Council. That is not technically before the Council as part of the reopening for a modification of the tower site location.

Nevertheless, in anticipation of a motion by the Town for such consideration by the Council, we have included information from Mr. Libertine as to his opinion related to the approved flush mount brown monopole and any alternative form of tower. This can be found at Q.9 within his direct testimony. Additionally, while no interrogatories were served on AT&T by the Town or other parties or intervenors, we were asked by the Town at the pre-hearing conference for information on the diameter of the proposed pole and that of a flagpole which I am advised is as follows: Proposed monopole - tapers from 32.35" diameter at the base to 17" at the 110' AGL height; Flagpole - minimal taper and 36" diameter at the 110' AGL height.

Thank you for your consideration of the enclosed.
