## NEW CINGULAR WIRELESS PCS, LLC ("AT&T") SUPPLEMENTAL SUBMISSION

- 1. Attached is a map with AT&T's baseline drive data for its network in this area of the State which was collected in 2008. No sites have been activated in this area of the State since collection of the data depicted on the attached map.
- 2. AT&T's data shown on the drive test and propagation maps are in the 800 Mhz frequency bands. Coverage for 1900 Mhz bands would be less given the nature of the frequencies involved.
- 3. The initial AT&T facility will be equipped with 880-894 Mhz frequencies and GSM and UMTS technologies. 1900 Mhz frequencies may be used in the future as well. GSM and UMTS are technologies that support AT&T's current voice, data and other service offerings to its wireless subscribers..
- 4. AT&T's back up power source relies primarily on batteries which are gel based and located in the equipment building itself providing for several layers of safety and containment. AT&T is reviewing its additional back up power source needs and may migrate in the future to use of an on-site permanent generator which could be installed on the concrete pad shown for AT&T's use and where any temporary mobile generator would be located during a prolonged power outage. A permanent back up generator if used by AT&T would consist of an enclosed diesel fueled 50/60 kW facility manufactured by Generac with a sound attenuation enclosure.
