To Whom It May Concern:


This firm represents Phoenix Partnership, LLC ("Phoenix"). Phoenix intends to file an application for a certificate for environmental compatibility and public need (the "Application") with the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") regarding certain real property commonly known as 50 Devine Street, North Haven (the "Property"). Phoenix seeks to construct, maintain and operate a telecommunications facility on the Property.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50f and § 16-50f-1 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, notice is hereby given that Phoenix Partnership, LLC ("Phoenix") will file an application with the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council"). Phoenix will file an application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a wireless communications facility at 50 Devine Street, North Haven, Connecticut (the "Application"). Phoenix will file the Application on or about August 6, 2009. Phoenix seeks to construct a new 120 foot, self-supporting monopole tower, with antennae, associated equipment and other site improvements necessary for the proposed facility (the "Facility"). The location, height and other features of the Facility are subject to review and change by the Council pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50g *et seq.*

The Facility will provide wireless service in the Town of North Haven, specifically along Devine Street, as well as on Interstate 91, State Highway 40 and Wilbur Cross Parkway (State Highway 15). The Application will set forth the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and will also describe the environmental impact, if any, of the Facility.

Phoenix will conduct a balloon float at the proposed height of the Facility on the day of the public hearing on the Application as scheduled by the Council. The Council will provide notice of the public hearing date. The Council will conduct that public hearing in North Haven. The balloon float will take place between 1:00p.m. and 6:00p.m. or as set by the Council.
