This letter and enclosures are being sent on behalf of North Atlantic Towers, LLC ("NAT") and New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC ("AT&T") to notify you of a very minor change to the equipment compound area for the above-referenced Facility as approved in Docket No. 423.

Per the utility company, the multi-tenant utility backboard must be located outside of the equipment compound fence. To accommodate this requirement, the equipment compound fence was shifted approximately seven (7) feet to the north on the western side of the fence gate. With this very minor shift to a small section of the equipment compound fence, the utility backboard remains in the location shown on the approved D&M Plans and outside of the fenced-in area. Enclosed are two drawings to illustrate this minor change to the equipment compound fence. The first drawing, C2 Enlarged Site Plan, last revised August 23, 2012, shows the fence enclosing the equipment compound and the utility backboard. The second drawing, EX-1 Exhibit Plan, dated December 20, 2012, depicts the slight adjustment to a portion of the equipment compound fence to accommodate the requirement that the utility backboard be located outside of the fence.
