Notice of Re-commencement of Construction Activities at Card Street Substations

Dear Chairman Stein:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company hereby provides written notification to the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) that construction activities associated with modifications to the Card Street Substation are expected to re-commence on or about February 24, 2014. In March 2014, construction activities also are expected to commence at Lake Road Switching Station and Killingly Substation

Initially, the work at Card Street Substation will focus on activities regarding the preparations for the outage that is planned to commence on March 17, including assembling switches, mobilizing equipment, and organizing material. During the March outage, two additional direct embed structures will be installed, as required for the temporary bus. This work will be performed by the contracting firm of E.S. Boulos. Pursuant to Section 16-50j-61(c)(8) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, CL&P provided to the Council contact information for E.S. Boulos on September 20, 2013, as part of CL&P's overall Notice for the Commencement of Construction at stations.

CL&P will provide contact information for other substation and switching station contractors at a later date.

CL&P recommends that the Council's Independent Environmental Inspector, BSC Group, should re-commence inspections of the station work.
