RE: **DOCKET NO. 424** - The Connecticut Light & Power Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Connecticut portion of the Interstate Reliability Project that traverses the municipalities of Lebanon, Columbia, Coventry, Mansfield, Chaplin, Hampton, Brooklyn, Pomfret, Killingly, Putnam, Thompson, and Windham, which consists of (a) new overhead 345-kV electric transmission lines and associated facilities extending between CL&P's Card Street Substation in the Town of Lebanon, Lake Road Switching Station in the Town of Killingly, and the Connecticut/Rhode Island border in the Town of Thompson; and (b) related additions at CL&P's existing Card Street Substation, Lake Road Switching Station, and Killingly Substation.

Dear Mr. Morissette:

Pursuant to a decision made in accordance with R.C.S.A. §16-50j-62 (b) at a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on September 19, 2013, and in response to your email of July 1, 2014, Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan to allow construction activities associated with the above project to occur until sunset on July 1, 2, and 3, 2014 at Card Street Substation in Lebanon. The extended work hours will allow contractors time to pour concrete for the footing foundations and install the terminal structure for the new 3271 Line. All construction activities that are the subject of this request will be confined to the substation.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hours requested in your email of July 1, 2014. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on September 19, 2013. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Our contractor, ES Boulos (ESB), is requesting permission to work at Card Street Substation beyond the 7:00 PM work hour limit to sunset for today, Wednesday and Thursday (July 1, 2, and 3). The request is in case they need the extra time to pour concrete for the footing foundations and installation of the terminal structure for the new 3271 line at Card Street Substation.
