Dear Neighbor,

This letter is to let you know that The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) is continuing its efforts to improve the transmission system in southwest Connecticut so customers will have reliable electric power to meet their growing energy needs. We will be seeking approval from the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) to construct and operate a new underground 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between the Glenbrook Substation in Stamford, Connecticut, and the South End Substation, also in Stamford.

CL&P is also asking the Council for approval to make related modifications of those substations, including the modifications described below, to the Glenbrook Substation on CL&P's property located on Lincoln Avenue in Stamford, which abuts or is near your property.

This letter will serve as notice of CL&P's intent to apply to the Council on or about January 18, 2013, for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for this project. The enclosed Public Notice provides further information about the project and the Council's process. If approved by the Council, construction is projected to begin in the first quarter of 2014, with completion scheduled for later that year. Please note that this work will not interrupt electric service to homes or businesses.

CL&P's application will include the following proposed modifications within the existing fence at the Glenbrook Substation: addition of a cable termination structure to support the new underground 115-kV electric transmission line; a motor-operated disconnect switch; a 115-kV circuit breaker; lightning arresters; three potential transformers; control cables in existing conduit; line metering, relay and control equipment; and foundations for new equipment.
