Pursuant to a decision made in accordance with Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62 (b) at a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on December 12, 2013, and in response to your email of November 6, 2014, Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan to allow construction activities associated with the above project on Sunday, November 9, 2014 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. These work hours will allow CL&P to perform paving work on private property located at 80-90 Lincoln Street in Stamford, Connecticut.

This approval applies only to the work hours requested in your email of November 6, 2014. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on December 12, 2013. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to R.C.S.A. §16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) hereby requests Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff approval of a Development and Management (D&M) Plan Change for the change in work hours described below pursuant to Sections 4.2 and 7.2 of the Stamford Reliability Cable Project (Project) D&M Plan - Volume II of III, for the new 115-kV Underground Transmission Line.

CL&P seeks Council staff approval for work on Sunday, November 9, 2014, from 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM to perform paving work on the private property located at 80-90 Lincoln Avenue. The Sunday work hours are needed to accommodate a specific request from a tenant to perform the work during off business hours- CL&P is exploring with the tenant and the paving plant the possibility of performing the work on Saturday, November 8, 2014, but if we are unsuccessful work would be on Sunday, as requested by the tenant. The work hours will allow CL&P to complete the work with less impact to the customer, prior to the winter season and before the paving plants close.

The City of Stamford (City) Noise Control Ordinance exempts construction activities between 10:00 AM and 5 PM on Sundays.
