Dear Mr. Morissette:

Pursuant to a decision made in accordance with Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62 (b) at a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on December 12, 2013, and in response to your email of July 17, 2014, Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan to allow construction activities associated with the above project to occur within a 12-hour period (Monday - Saturday from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM). The extended work hours will allow construction to occur for the pipe jacking operation location at 80 Lincoln Street, Stamford, Connecticut.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hours requested in your email of July 17, 2014. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on December 12, 2013. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to R.C.S.A. §16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.
