Dear Chairman Robert Stein and Members of the Connecticut Siting Council:

On behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T"), please accept this letter and drawings as an update to the Development and Management Plan ("D&M Plan") currently under review for the captioned Facility approved in Docket 437.

Included as Attachment 1 please find fifteen (15) sets of 11" x 17" construction drawings being filed in accordance with the Council's Decision and Order dated September 5, 2013 ("Decision and Order"). A revised structural analyses of the tower (Attachment 2) and platform (Attachment 3) are also enclosed demonstrating that these changes can be accommodated structurally.

No change to the details regarding the access drive or compound previously submitted are proposed and only changes to the antenna/equipment configuration on the tower are planned. AT&T originally proposed 12 antennas with 18 remote radio heads. The current plan consists of 12 antennas and a total of 21 radio head units along with 6 small A2 units; details of these A2 units are provided in Attachment 4.

In addition, we have the following clarifications in response to questions discussed with Siting Analyst Mercier:

1. Silt Fence Perimeter: The planned silt fencing extends to the north some distance from the work area as the fencing location was delineated in consultation with APT as part of necessary turtle protection measures.
2. Kestrel: As noted during the June 25, 2013 hearing, no kestrel activity was observed in the area and further that the compound/tower location is in a small pocket of interior forest not favored by kestrels. Docket 437 3:00pm Transcript,

June 25, 2013, p. 13. The most suitable habitat near the compound and tower is instead located along the property line. Docket 437 3:00pm Transcript, June 25, 2013, p. 13. As per the Applicant's July 23, 2013 submission, plantings to the north of the access drive were planned to enhance the "edge effect" habitat along the margins of the small forest block in order to provide food, cover and nesting sites for avian species.

As per the Siting Council's regulations and the Decision and Order in this Docket, this submission is being provided to both the property owner and the Town of Bridgewater.

We respectfully request that this revised D&M submission be included on the next available Siting Council agenda Thank you for your consideration of the enclosed.


