RE: **DOCKET NO. 461A** - Eversource Energy Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115-kilovolt (kV) bulk substation located at 290 Railroad Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut, and two 115-kV underground transmission circuits extending approximately 2.3 miles between the proposed substation and the existing Cos Cob Substation, Greenwich, Connecticut, and related substation improvements. Development and Management Plan.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in accordance with the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) Decision and Order for the above referenced project dated November 9, 2017, Council staff hereby approves the use of a temporary material laydown/staging area located at the Bruce Museum in Greenwich, as detailed in Eversource's correspondence dated June 4, 2019.

The temporary material laydown/staging area will be located on approximately 3,500 square feet of the northeastern portion of the Bruce Museum parking lot designated in consultation with the Town of Greenwich. The laydown area consists of a paved area encompassing 8 parking spaces. The laydown/staging area will be isolated from adjacent areas using temporary chain link fencing with privacy screening.

The staging area/laydown area will be used to store Project construction materials and support equipment, and may be accessed 24 hours a day, depending on the Project's day-or night-time construction activities.

This approval applies only to the temporary material laydown/staging area presented in Eversource's request of June 4, 2019. Any additional changes to the approved D&M Plan require advance notification and approval. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62. Please be advised that deviations from the D&M Plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.
