RE: **DOCKET NO. 466** - The Connecticut Light & Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Frost Bridge to Campville 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line project that traverses the municipalities of Watertown, Thomaston, Litchfield, and Harwinton, which consists of (a) construction, maintenance and operation of a new 115-kV overhead electric transmission line entirely within existing Eversource right-of-way and associated facilities extending approximately 10.4 miles between Eversource's existing Frost Bridge Substation in the Town of Watertown and existing Campville Substation in the Town of Harwinton; (b) related modifications to Frost Bridge Substation and Campville Substation; and (c) reconfiguration of a 0.4 mile segment of two existing 115-kV electric transmission lines across the Naugatuck River in the Towns of Litchfield and Harwinton within the same existing right-of-way as the new 115-kV electric transmission line.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email of April 28, 2017, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced project to allow construction activities to include the following Sundays:

- May 7, 2017 in the Town of Litchfield between 7 AM and 7 PM and the Town of Harwinton between 9 AM and 7 PM for work on the Naugatuck River Crossing. Work is necessary to complete critical construction activities in advance of an approved outage sequence; and
- May 14 and May 21, 2017 between 9 AM and 7 PM at the Campville Substation in Harwinton. All work would be performed within the control house in support of planned outages.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hours requested in your email of April 28, 2017. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on September 15, 2016. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.



Dear Ms. Bachman:

Pursuant to the Connecticut Siting Council (Council's) approval letter for the above-referenced Docket's Development and Management (D&M) Plan dated September 16, 2016, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) requests that Council staff review and approve work hours on three Sundays in May, as follows:

Sunday, May 7, 2017 (Transmission Line). Due to the inclement weather this week and in anticipation of inclement weather currently forecast for the week of May 1 (and which has the potential to delay construction), this Sunday work is needed to complete critical construction activities in advance of the Project's approved outage sequence regarding the transmission line conductor installation at the Naugatuck River. The Sunday work hours are consistent with the work hours presented and approved by the Council in the Project's D&M Plan.

The Sunday work would be localized at the following structure sites and along the transmission line right-of-way and access roads leading to these sites:

- Town of Litchfield. Structures 85 and 86; refer to D&M Plan, Volume 3, mapsheets 30, 31, and 31A; Hours - 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
- Town of Harwinton. Structures 87 and 88, refer to D&M Plan, Volume 3, mapsheets 32 and 33; Hours - 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Sunday, May 14 and 21, 2017 (Campville Substation, Harwinton) between 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM. All work would be performed at Campville Substation within the control enclosure. The work would also be required to support the outage sequence for the transmission line construction.
