FairwindCT, Inc. (“FairwindCT”) requests that the intervenor, Connecticut Light and Power Company (“CL&P”), respond to the following interrogatories:

1. When did BNE Energy, Inc. (“BNE”), first approach or contact you with respect to the project that is the subject of Petition No. 980 (“Wind Prospect”)?
2. If Wind Prospect is approved and constructed, what work will need to be done by CL&P to integrate the electricity generated from Wind Prospect into the grid?
3. How much will the work described in Interrogatory No. 2 cost?
4. Who will pay for the costs described in Interrogatory No. 3?
5. Please provide copies of any documents related to your Scoping Meeting with CL&P regarding Wind Prospect.
6. Please provide copies of any documents related to your Application Request and Application Review with BNE regarding Wind Prospect.
7. Has the Feasibility Study regarding Wind Prospect been completed? If so, please provide a copy of that study. If not, when do you expect it to be completed?


8. Has the System Impact Study regarding Wind Prospect been completed? If so, please provide a copy of that study. If not, when do you expect it to be completed?

9. Has the Transmission Study regarding Wind Prospect been completed? If so, please provide a copy of that study. If not, when do you expect it to be completed?

10. Do you have a power purchase agreement with BNE? If so, please provide a copy.

11. If you do not have a power purchase agreement, have you been involved in communications regarding a power purchase agreement with BNE? If so, please state the date on which such communications began, name the individuals involved in those communications, describe the present status of those communications and provide an estimate of when you anticipate executing that agreement.

12. What price is CL&P presently paying for Class I renewable energy?
