Whereas, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative for the 24th Assembly District occasioned by the **resignation of the incumbent, effective 11:30 A.M. November 15, 2011;**

And Whereas, the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut has made provision for an Election to fill such vacancy, as appears by Section 9-215 of the General Statutes of Connecticut;

You are, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Connecticut, hereby ordered and directed to warn a meeting of the Electors of the Town of **Newington** in the County of Hartford, to be holden on the **10th day of January, A.D. 2012**, at the place or places of holding biennial Electors' Meetings, then and there to give in their votes for a person to fill the office of **State Representative** for the **24th Assembly District** for the remainder of the official term commencing on the **10th day of January, A.D. 2012**, which meeting shall be holden and the returns thereof made pursuant to the provisions of the Statute hereinbefore referred to.
