ETHICS TRAINING

Original Ethics 101 Online Course

“Ethics 101” for public officials and state employees’ course has been updated and will serve to familiarize you with Connecticut’s Office of State Ethics and the ethics laws to which members of the SEC are subject.

Throughout the course you will be asked a series of ungraded knowledge check questions regarding the course material. When you answer the questions correctly, you will advance to the next section. At the end of the course, you must pass a final assessment with a minimum score of 80% to demonstrate competency of the material.

This training takes approximately 30 – 40 minutes to complete, depending on the speed of each individual learner.
