Call to Order Chairman Shirley called the meeting to order at 10:00 am.

Chairman Shirley asked for a motion to approve the May 2022 meeting minutes. Motion made by Michael Jefferson Seconded by Ojala Naeem All in favor – All Motion passed. Minutes approved.

The Committee proceeded to discuss the community reinvestment item on the agenda. Executive Director Clay indicates that staff will start drafting a community reinvestment plan for the council to consider however all members should provide their thoughts on this subject. Discussion ensued.

After this discussion, the committee proceeded to discuss the next item on the agenda which is the proposed legislative recommendations. Kristina Diamond explained that she emailed the members of the Council regarding potential legislative recommendations. Councilmember Jefferson has suggested that SEC should consider reviewing some of the proposals that were previously included in the legislative package submitted during the previous session and were not acted upon by the legislature. Discussion ensued.

Executive Director Clay has expressed her concerns that the towns and cities identified as a DIA have issued moratoriums or prohibitions on cannabis. Discussion ensued. Andrea Comer emphasized that residents should not be punished for the decisions of their towns. Michael Jefferson has suggested the idea of sliding scale for community reinvestment purposes to solve this problem. The example of how New York deals with this issue was provided by Director Clay.

The meeting ended by Councilmember Jefferson congratulating the SEC, the staff, and the third-party reviewer for an amazing job. All members agreed.
