SUBJECT: **Tropical Storm/Hurricane Henri**

> The primary purpose of this communication is to ensure that your facility is prepared for the potential impact of Tropical Storm/Hurricane Henri making landfall in Connecticut this weekend.

Emergency Preparedness Checklist

There is a strong possibility that Tropical Storm/Hurricane Henri will impact Connecticut this weekend with strong winds, potentially flooding rain and power outages. All providers should take a moment to review their storage and handling practices with all relevant staff. Each practice should have a back-up protocol for vaccine recovery. Providers should take all steps necessary to safeguard the viability of their vaccine before the tropical storm/hurricane hits. Such steps include having a generator on site in case power is lost, activating your emergency back-up plan, or making arrangements with a facility that has a generator (local hospital, pharmacy, fire station, another practice, private residence etc.) to temporarily store your vaccine supply. If you do experience a power outage and do not have a generator, do not assume the vaccine is no longer viable. Instead, record the date, time and temperature and contact each vaccine manufacturer to determine if the vaccine is still good to use. Remember do not discard or administer affected vaccines until you have discussed the viability of such vaccine with each vaccine manufacturer. We appreciate all the time and effort you and your staff are taking to safeguard all vaccines in your possession and minimize any vaccine loss.
