**SUBJECT:** Vaccine Temperature Monitoring

The primary purpose of this communication is to remind providers to make provisions to continue monitoring refrigerator and freezer temperatures while offices may have shortened hours or be closing altogether.

#### Temperature Monitoring

Many providers receiving CVP vaccine are feeling the impacts of the Coronavirus outbreak and have either shortened their hours of operation or shut their offices down for a short period of time. Please remember that any CVP vaccine you have stored in your offices must continue to be monitored to ensure its stability and viability.
